

Information you should know about 2day pass Ticket

- [1] In order to use the pass, simply insert the pass into the automatic ticket machine gates.
- [2] Please keep in mind that the purchase of a reserved-seat ticket is required for seating on cars with reserved seating arrangements.
- [3] Each pass is valid for only one person.
- [4] Please take care not to lose your NANKAI ALL LINE 2day Pass. Passes cannot be re-issued.
- [5] After activating the pass, refunds are not available even if train services are suspended.
- (6) Refunds can only be made for unused passes within the validation period at the ticket office you purchased or exchanged it. (Refund charge is required.)

NANKAI ALL LINE 2day Pass

A 2-day, all-you-can-ride pass on all the Nankai Electric Railway lines!

Valid thru

- 1. If you exchange during January 1 to March 31, the 2 day pass is available for 2 optional days until April 30 in the same year.
- 2. If you exchange during April 1 to December 31, the 2 day pass is available for 2 optional days until April 30 in the next year.

of the trains is colored with pink or light blue, while


